## The Property

Recently renovated to the highest standards, Property 10216 combines traditional Italian furniture with modern luxury, offering a peaceful haven for up to 14 guests in 7 elegantly appointed bedrooms.

Outdoors, the freshwater pool (10 x 5 m), set against a Roman ruin, offers a refreshing dip. Guests can also access secluded rocky coves a few steps away. Although the beach is not sandy and may not be ideal for young children or elderly guests, it features a wooden platform with sunbeds and umbrellas for a comfortable spot by the water. For a sandy beach, a beautiful shore is just a 10-minute drive away. Expansive terraces provide ample space for al fresco dining, while the surrounding park with its private pine forest invites leisurely walks.

The villa offers two floors designed to ensure comfort and privacy. The ground floor features a spacious living room with a fireplace and a terrace with sea views. A fully-equipped kitchen with a dining table is perfect for group meals, while a separate utility kitchen provides extra convenience. The floor also accommodates four double bedrooms, each with an en-suite bathroom with a shower. The upper floor includes three double bedrooms, two bathrooms with a shower, and an additional living area. Air conditioning is available on both floors.
