Location and Surrounding Area

Located just ten minutes from the magnificent Archaeological Park of Selinunte and the beach of Marinella di Selinunte, this three-bedroom property is perfectly situated to offer complete privacy and tranquility to its guests, providing a perfect retreat for those who want to explore this area's beautiful beaches and crystal-clear waters. Situated in western Sicily, the villa provides a unique opportunity to admire Sicily's splendid landscapes while soaking up the region's incredibly rich historical and cultural heritage.

Carpeted with vineyards and olive groves, Southwestern Sicily is home to some of the Mediterranean's most fascinating Greek archaeological sites. Highlighted by the Temple of Concordia, the Valley of the Temples is one of the most extensive and representative archaeological sites of classical Greek civilization. Nestled among olive trees on a ridge near the sea, Agrigento boasts some of the best-preserved Greek temples in the world as well as sparkling beaches, marvelous islands and crystal-clear waters.

The coastal strip between Agrigento and Sciacca is dotted with gorgeous, yet still-unknown beaches encircled by sand dunes and white cliffs. The curving white walls of Scala dei Turchi form an exceptional backdrop: a large staircase-shaped white cliff reflecting the light of the sun and enhancing the blue of the sea below. The unspoiled dunes of Porto Palo embody the African soul of Southern Sicily: despite its limited services, this peaceful corner boasts fine sand, shallow depths and limpid waters that will not disappoint.

The villa is just a stone's throw from Sciacca, a lively seaside town in the Southwest of the island. Important center for the ceramic manufacturing, sought-after holiday resort especially by young people and famous for organizing the most beautiful Sicilian Carnival, Sciacca has by now grown as a significant resort on the Southern coast of Sicily. Located 100 km off the coast of Sicily, Pantelleria boasts gorgeous swimming spots, including the famous Balata dei Turchi Bay, Martingana and Kattibuale.

The villa is also a few kilometers from Marsala. Many know about its sweet dessert wines, but few people realize what a charmer the town of Marsala is. Though its streets are paved in gleaming marble, lined with stately baroque buildings and peppered with graceful piazzas, Marsala has pleasures that are simple: a friendly evening stroll, also known as passeggiata, most nights, plenty of aperitif options and family-friendly restaurants aplenty.

Having been the crossroads of civilizations for millennia, Palermo delivers a heavily spiced mix of Byzantine mosaics, Arabesque domes and frescoed cupolas. This is a city at the edge of Europe and at the heart of the ancient world, a place where souk-like markets rub up against baroque churches, where date palms frame Gothic palaces and where the blue-eyed and fair have bronze-skinned cousins. Centuries of dizzying highs and crushing lows have formed a complex metropolis.
