Location and Surrounding Area

Set in the countryside of Monteroni d'Arbia, Property 10689 enjoys a truly privileged location. The villa is just a short drive from Siena, allowing you to explore its historic centre, while also being perfectly placed for day trips to the Val d'Orcia and its charming hilltop villages, renowned wineries, and breathtaking landscapes.

Just a short drive from the villa lies the medieval city of Siena, one of Tuscany's most treasured gems. Famed for its stunning Piazza del Campo, where the historic Palio horse race takes place twice a year, Siena offers a wealth of architectural and artistic wonders to explore. Stroll through its narrow-cobbled streets, visit the magnificent Duomo with its intricate marble façade, and soak up the city's timeless atmosphere while enjoying a coffee in one of its charming cafés.

The villa is also perfectly positioned for discovering the Val d'Orcia, a UNESCO World Heritage Site celebrated for its postcard-perfect scenery. Rolling hills dotted with solitary farmhouses, vineyards, and cypress trees create an unforgettable landscape. Here, you can visit some of Tuscany's most iconic villages, including Pienza, known for its pecorino cheese and Renaissance architecture, and Montalcino, the birthplace of the world-famous Brunello wine, where you can enjoy wine tastings and vineyard tours.

For those wishing to explore further, the villa offers easy access to other must-see destinations such as Montepulciano, renowned for its Vino Nobile and elegant palazzi, and San Gimignano, the "Medieval Manhattan" with its distinctive towers and panoramic views. Nature lovers will delight in leisurely walks, cycling routes, and scenic drives through the countryside, discovering hidden abbeys, charming villages, and breathtaking viewpoints along the way.

The Property

Perched high atop a hill in the Tuscan countryside, Property 10689 is a masterfully restored farmhouse that blends timeless character with refined luxury. Every detail has been designed to honour the estate's 400-year-old history while offering state-of-the-art amenities to ensure a seamless stay. With over 700 square metres of living space, Property 10689 sleeps up to 12 guests across six bedrooms spread across the main house (4 bedrooms) and a beautifully restored barn (2 bedrooms), with 4 extra guests on two queen-size sofa beds.

Step outside and discover five acres of perfectly maintained grounds, framed by rows of cypress trees and olive trees. The infinity pool (18 m), complete with Roman steps, invites you to unwind while taking in 360-degree views of the Crete Senesi and the towers of Siena in the distance. A paved sunbathing area with loungers, a heated hot tub, and several al fresco dining spaces provide the perfect setting to enjoy long Tuscan days under the sun. The pool house includes a sauna, a fitness room, and a dedicated space for spa treatments.

The estate's rich past adds an extra layer of fascination to your stay. First recorded in 1598, Property 10689 once stood along a pilgrimage route to Rome and has witnessed centuries of Tuscan life, even housing the French Commander of the Allied troops during WWII. Today, thanks to an exceptional restoration project led by expert architects and local craftsmen, it stands as a unique place to experience authentic Tuscany, a perfect balance of heritage and modernity.

Inside, Property 10689 combines rustic elegance with modern comfort. Original wood beams, cotto floors, and stone archways have been carefully restored and paired with a contemporary layout. The

spacious kitchen and dining area includes a traditional Tuscan fireplace. An open living room with an adjacent viewing room provides ample space for socialising, while the forno room with its original brick oven adds authentic charm. Guests can also enjoy the interior courtyard with a pergola-covered dining area.

Main House (4 Bedrooms):

On the main level, the first master suite has a king-size bed, an en-suite bathroom with bathtub and shower, and a living room with a convertible sofa bed, fireplace, and air conditioning. Upstairs are three bedrooms: the second master suite features a king-size bed, en-suite with freestanding bathtub and shower, walk-in wardrobe, and private sitting room. The third bedroom has a king-size bed with en-suite, while the fourth can be set up with two twin beds or a king-size bed, also with an en-suite shower.

Barn (2 Bedrooms):

The restored barn provides a separate living space ideal for guests seeking additional privacy. Its upper level features two bedrooms: a magnificent master suite with king-size bed, freestanding bathtub, large shower, and air conditioning, paired with a private seating area on the main level featuring a kitchenette, fireplace, and convertible sofa bed; and a sixth bedroom with either two twin beds or one king bed, an en-suite shower room, and air conditioning.
