Visitors can enjoy wine and olive oil tastings at local estates, walk or cycle through the picturesque countryside, or visit charming towns such as Montecarlo di Lucca, famous for its vineyards, or Collodi, the birthplace of Pinocchio, with its enchanting historic gardens. 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The Property

L'Olivo is a beautifully restored 16th-century olive press that now offers a warm and inviting Tuscan retreat for up to 8 guests. Once the private press of the noble Controni family, this historic residence retains its timeless charm while offering modern comforts across four individually styled double bedrooms, each with its own en-suite bathroom. A welcoming living area and a spacious Tuscan kitchen with an eat-in breakfast room provide the perfect setting for relaxed gatherings in true Italian style.

Set amid terraced olive groves, the villa's grounds offer a spectacular panorama across the valley to the medieval towers of Lucca. The floodlit swimming pool (8 x 4 m, depth 1.80 m) is framed by greenery and enjoys breathtaking views, while a barbecue and outdoor dining area in front of the villa's striking red façade create an idyllic spot for al fresco dinners under the stars. With the scent of olives in the air and the soft rustle of the trees, this is a place to experience the very essence of Tuscan living.

Inside, L'Olivo exudes classic country charm with beamed ceilings, traditional furnishings, and rich fabrics evoking an authentic, yet refined, rustic atmosphere. The ground floor features a cosy TV room, a fully equipped kitchen, and a dining room with seating for eight, while the first floor houses the four bedrooms: three double rooms (bed size $170 \times 190 \text{ cm}$) and one twin room with two beds ($90 \times 200 \text{ cm}$), which can be joined to form a double.

Each room is equipped with a safe, and the entire house offers Wi-Fi, a centralised music system, satellite TV, DVD player, and a video library for guests' entertainment. L'Olivo is more than just a villa—it is a piece of Tuscan history lovingly preserved and thoughtfully designed for guests seeking both
