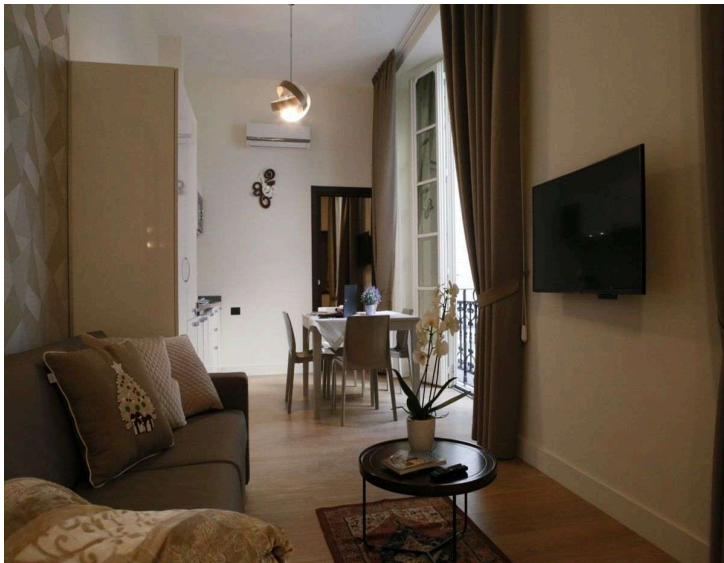

Location and Surrounding Area. This elegant property, located in the heart of Naples is found in Piazza Nicola Amore in one of the “Four Palaces” that adorn the square. This architectural masterpiece inspired by the Renaissance dates from the end of the 19th century and is drenched in history. It is a place where one is stunned with luxury, where guests can take in the sights of this magical city.

Naples which is full of cathedrals, sea views, history and incredible food. Visit Via Dei Tribunali where you can find the perfect Pizza Margherita, head to San Gregoria Ameno street to see the artisan pastoral crafts or to the National Archaeological Museum housing an incredible collection of antiquities. Shop till you drop on Via Roma to end up in Piazza Del Plebiscito where you will find Castel Nuovo, San Carlo, the oldest opera house in Europe and the Royal Palace. In close proximity is the seafront lined with bars and restaurants and a view of Capri and the Sorrentino Coast. The joy of sightseeing in Naples is vast: you can soak up the sun with your family at the beaches of Posillipo, stroll around the narrow streets of the historical centre or have a twilight aperitivo with friends at Castel Del’Ovo.

When staying at Domus Apartments, one can take a day trip to the famous town of Positano with its steep, white, winding streets bustling to the beach. Perched on a cliff, it is one of the most visited vacation spots and is also part of the Sentiero degli Dei hiking trail. You might even have the opportunity to catch a performance in the Amphitheatre during their summer season of music, dance and theatre.

Sorrento, one of the most visited towns in the South of Italy with narrow, colorful streets and piazzas abuzz with locals and tourists can be reached in about an hour from the apartments. Grab a gelato and sit and watch the world go by in Piazza Tasso, view the several mosaicked churches, visit the tiled cloister of San Francesco, and peruse the famous wooden inlaid goods at the market as you take in the sea air overlooking the Bay of Naples.

Wherever you go in this area full of life and excitement, the guests can be assured that their days will be filled with scenes of beauty and history, delicious food and artistic delights. Domus Apartments is perfect for a family or small group of friends. It is about 6,5 km from Naples International Airport. The central train station and bus station is less than 1 km from the property and the nearest metro station (Universita’) is 600 metres. Positano is 62 km, Pompeii is 28 km and Sorrento is 51 km from the villa.

The Property. This unique contemporary setting of this property is found in the historic building located in one of the famed “Quattro Palazzi” of Piazza Nicola Amore.
