As you walk through the vast corridors, be prepared to be mesmerized by Michelangelo's transcendent masterpiece, the Sistine Chapel. Admire the intricate details of Raphael's School of Athens and countless other treasures that span centuries of artistic achievement. To make the most of your visit, consider a guided tour to unravel the best things and stories behind these unparalleled works of art.

Head to Piazza Navona, a magnificent square with a fountain by Bernini and a popular gathering point for Romans with its bustling terraced cafés and seasonal fairgrounds. Located near the famous Spanish Steps and the upscale shopping street Via dei Condotti, Piazza di Spagna is great for boutique shops and elegant restaurants. The place was used for wild beast hunts, public executions, and gladiator fights for several hundred years, then became a condo of sorts as medieval Romans made their homes in the hulking ruins.
