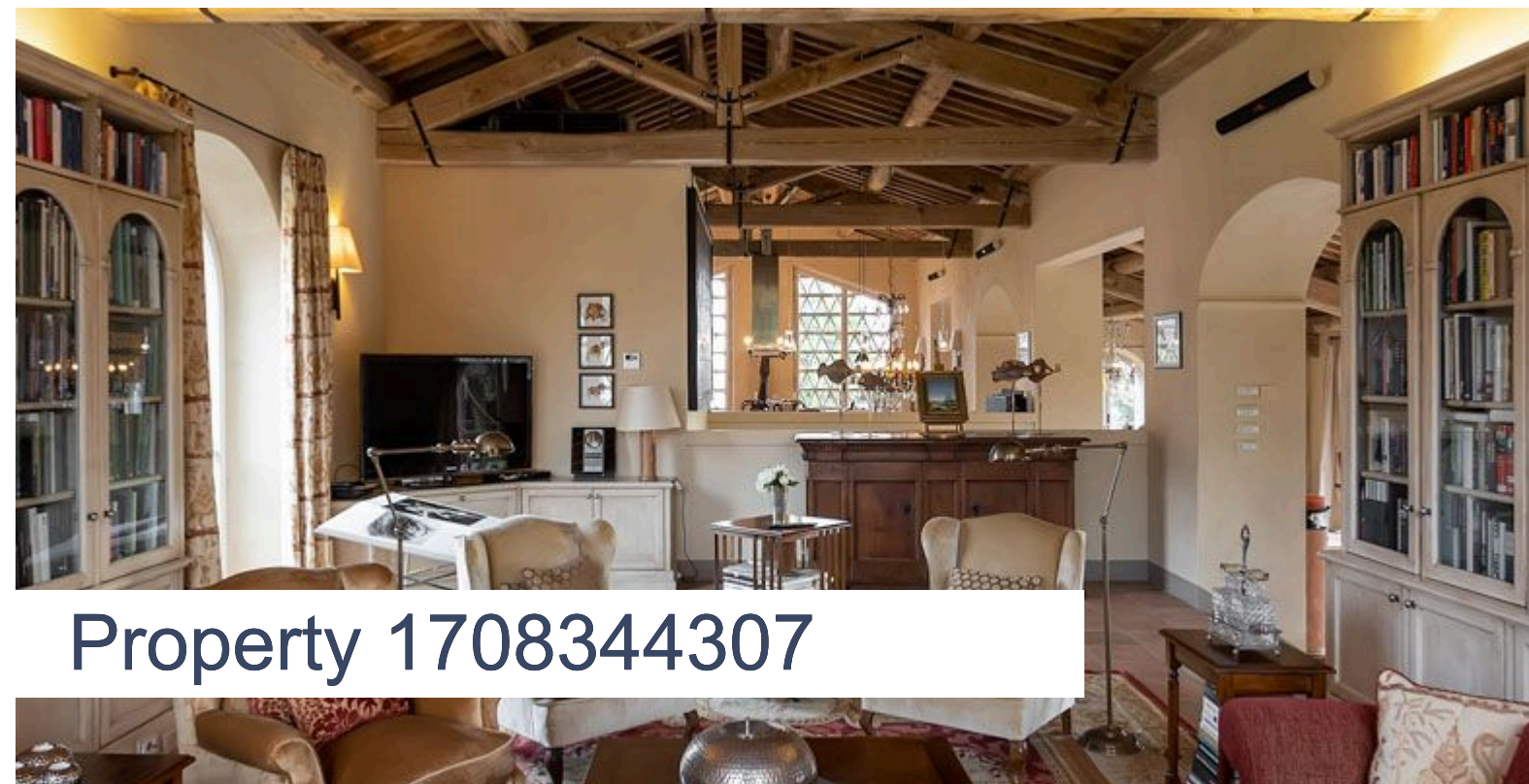

Location and Surrounding Area

Located near Lucca and surrounded by greenery, this contemporary property is ideally located to explore the region's cultural highlights and most spectacular natural wonders. During the warmer months, the second-largest comics festival in the world, Lucca Comics & Games, and renowned international artists take center stage during the Lucca Summer Festival.

In forty minutes by car, you can easily reach Pisa, which is exceptionally well-known for its Leaning Tower. Moving between its alleys and riversides, you will discover architectural jewels such as Santa Maria della Spina, the headquarters of the Scuola Normale Superiore in Piazza dei Cavalieri, the exhibitions of Palazzo Blu, and the magnetic charm of Piazza dei Miracoli. Start from the Baptistery and head to the 130-meter Camposanto Monumentale overlooking the square.

The villa is also forty minutes by car from Viareggio, the most important city in Versilia. Established as a port of Lucca, this popular sun-and-sand resort is extremely renowned for its flamboyant Carnevale, second only to Venice's carnival, and for its disheveled line-up of art nouveau facades along its seafront, which recall the town's 1920s and '30s heyday. Stroll along the city center's charming streets, eat a gelato on the Passeggiata, and look out to the sea on the Dersena.

Offering a serene atmosphere, the outdoor space features an al fresco dining area and lounge corners in the shade of wisteria flowers, perfect for intimate evenings and quiet moments.

Main Villa:

With stone walls and terracotta-tiled roofs, the main farmhouse is located close to the building that houses the wine tasting of the winery and gives access to the underground wine cellars. On the ground floor of the main villa, you will find three double bedrooms with an en-suite bathroom, one twin room, and one bathroom. Please note that the twin bedroom and a double bedroom on this floor do not feature air conditioning. However, the rooms remain quite cool during the summer.

On the first floor, which is the pool level, the main villa features a grand dining room, two living rooms, and a chef-grade kitchen. With a fully-equipped kitchen, you can savor the convenience and flexibility of home-cooked meals during your stay. In the living area, French windows give access to the back

garden, where the pool is found. Please note that, while the back garden is private and not accessible by people who work at the winery, the front garden is connected to the whole estate.

Hayloft:

With accommodation all on one level, the hayloft is accessible from the front garden. The apartment boasts a living and dining area, a fully-equipped kitchen, and a double bedroom with an en-suite bathroom. Please note that this building is located next to the main villa and hosts the apartment of the manager of the winery, a lovely and charming lady that will enchant you with her experience and passion for Lucca and good wine.
