

The Property

A cypress-lined avenue leads to the entrance, where a grand gate opens onto a courtyard garden with private parking. Beyond the reception hall, the rose garden is a charming setting for al fresco breakfasts, leisurely lunches, and candlelit dinners. At the far end, an elegant swimming pool with a Jacuzzi and fitness area offers a peaceful retreat, surrounded by a centuries-old olive grove and shaded by maritime pines. A changing room and guest facilities ensure comfort and convenience.

Steeped in history, Property 61 once played a vital role in the defence of the Tuscan Maremma before evolving into a distinguished noble residence. The Grand Duke Leopold II of Tuscany frequently resided here, making it a centre of aristocratic life. Today, the castle continues to enchant visitors with its regal ambience, captivating surroundings, and unparalleled hospitality, offering a truly unforgettable stay in the heart of Tuscany.

Inside, the castle's interiors evoke a sense of timeless sophistication. Each room is uniquely adorned with elegant antique furnishings, ornate hand-painted ceilings, and exquisite frescoes, creating an atmosphere of refined opulence and historic grandeur. Rich fabrics, artfully curated décor, and soft

The second staircase, adorned with antique suits of armour, leads to the Grand Duke's bedroom (Suite 3) in cardinal red, featuring antique furnishings, a 17th-century bed head, and a grand piano. It also provides access to Suites 1 and 2, both with lovely garden views: Suite 1 overlooks the southern garden, while Suite 2 faces the northern garden. All rooms are equipped with air conditioning, a minibar, a private safe, and satellite TV. The bathrooms feature hand-painted travertine marble, hairdryers, and bath towels.
